



How to take care of a fresh tattoo

Thank you for choosing us for your tattoo. We spent some unforgettable time together and here is a guide on how to care for a fresh tattoo.

What will you need?

- 1) Antibacterial soap – for example Protex
- 2) Bepanthen Plus
- 3) Tattoo cream, shea butter

After five days at the latest:

Remove the protective film under lukewarm running water. Wash the tattoo thoroughly but gently with cold or lukewarm water and antibacterial soap (do not use a washcloth or sponge). Do not soak the tattoo under water for a long time – it may start to “soak” and get damaged. After washing, dry it with a paper towel that will absorb the water – just apply it lightly. Apply a thin layer of Bepanthen Plus cream and do not cover the tattoo with anything. It is important that it is a really thin layer so that it does not soak again.

Care in the following days:

Apply Bepanthen Plus cream for 3 days, morning and evening with a thin layer. Then you can apply tattoo cream or shea butter once or twice a day. Tattoos usually heal in 7-10 days. The healed tattoo is smooth and may initially be shiny - the skin will completely heal in about a month.

Do not drink alcoholic beverages for 24 hours after the tattoo is completed. Limit their consumption during the healing process.

Do NOT soak the tattoo for a long time under water for the first week. Due to the risk of possible infection, do not visit the sauna, swimming pool, swimming pool, sea and avoid strenuous sports activities during the healing period.

Do not expose the tattoo to direct sunlight or solarium for the first month. Furthermore, always use sunscreen with a high protection factor when in the sun. If scabs form on the tattoo in places, do not scratch or peel them.

Internal healing of damaged skin can take up to several months.

Please note that changes may occur to your tattoo due to time, UV radiation and skin aging.

Therefore, take care of your tattoo by regularly using creams containing vitamin E, aloe, panthenol. Failure to follow the instructions, see the previous text, may result in irreversible damage to the tattoo and possible infection.
